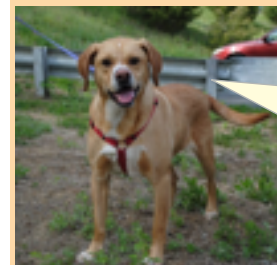
puppy. When his family was unable to keep him due to an illness, we took him back.

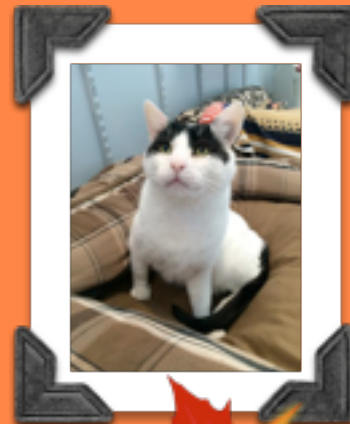
